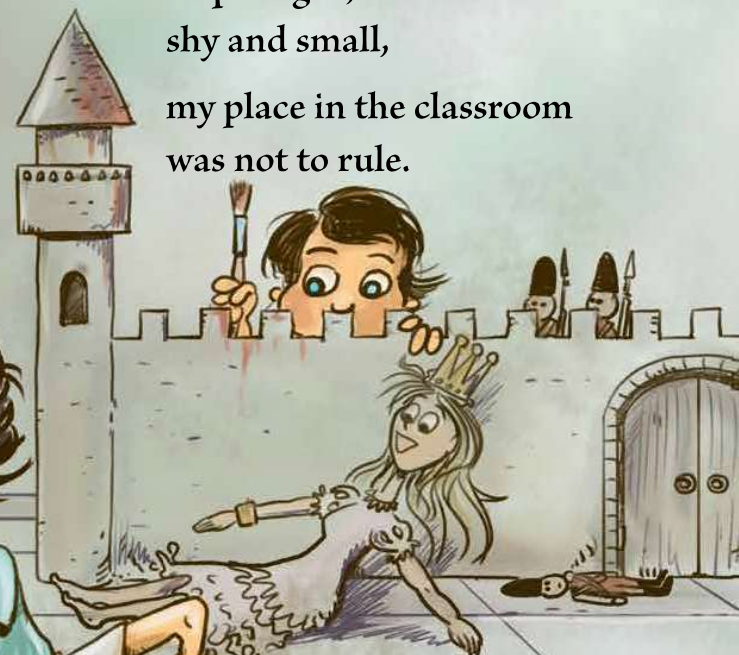

off the **pedals**.

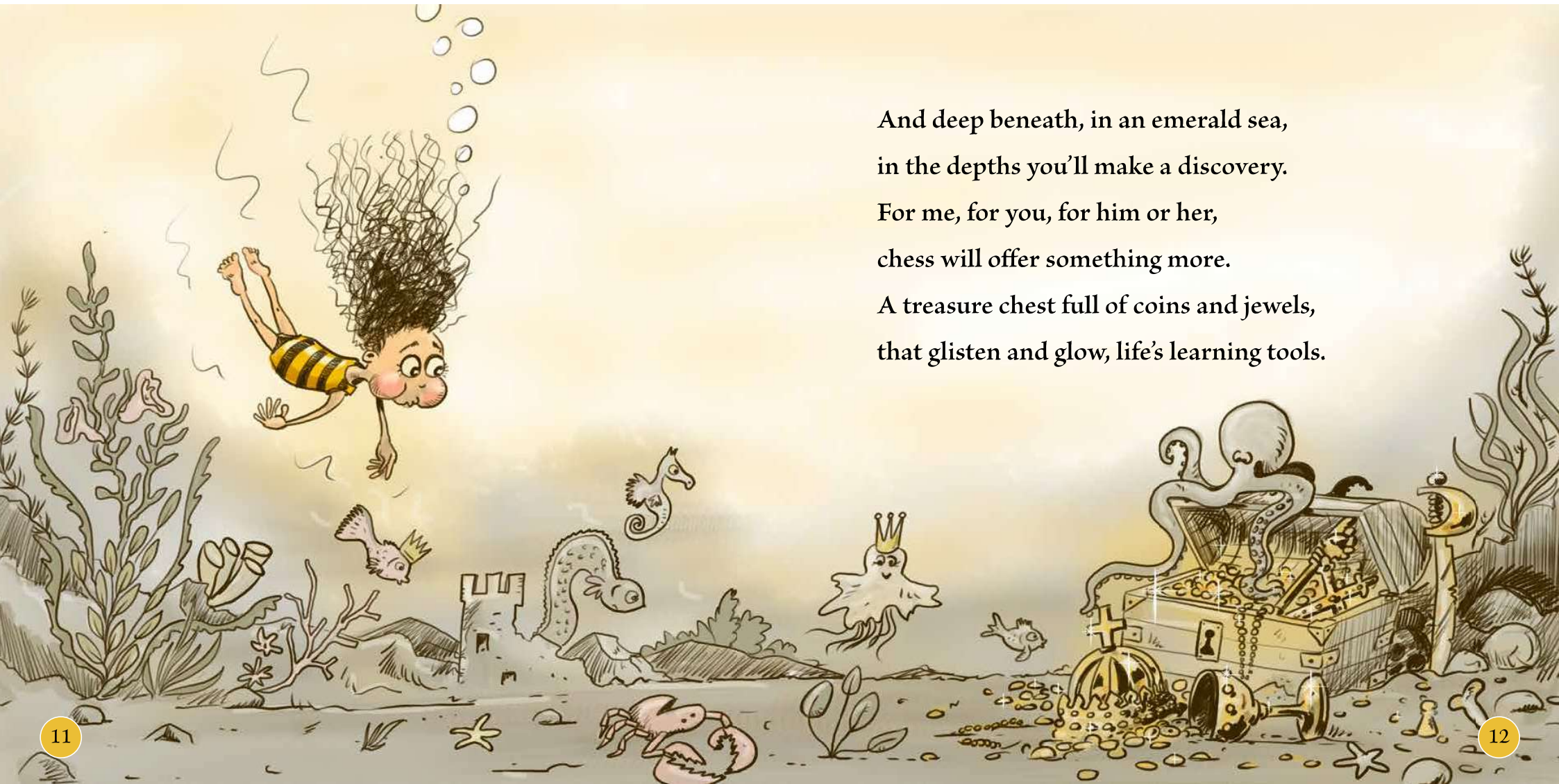
Chess will be there,
